Seattle NPR affiliate KUOW earlier this year [ran a story](#) about Vitae Foundation's billboards, ads and its YourOptions.com website. The story was biased as the KUOW reporter never contacted Vitae, yet put a Planned Parenthood spokesperson on the air to tear down our ads and website, stating they were "misleading."

After failed attempts to get the management at KUOW to provide an ombudsman to work out our issues with the story, followed by a request for an ethics policy which went unanswered, Vitae turned to the Washington News Council (WNC), where [a formal complaint](#) was filed. A hearing was held where General Manager of KUOW Guy Nelson and Vitae's West Coast Spokesperson Pia de Solenni came together and answered questions from the WNC. The WNC then [issued its recommendations](#).
