Dramatic Decrease in Missouri Abortions Reported

Vitae Foundation always braces itself for abortion numbers that are reported in Missouri. According to newly-released State Department of Health figures, Missouri women had 1,019 fewer abortions in 2010 than in the previous year – a 9.4 percent decline!

We get caught up in numbers and statistics all the time. We must remember the lives behind these statistics. We pray for the 9,796 babies that were lost to abortion and the mothers and families that have to deal with those losses. At the same time, we are grateful for the lives that were saved from abortion—as evidenced by this report.

“It was a God Thing”

Last fall Vitae ads were on billboards and on television in the St. Louis area, helping direct women facing unplanned pregnancies to Thrive St. Louis, a local Pregnancy Help Center. Even though the campaign ended on January 1, calls and texts continue to come in.

“I keep getting texts, and I know they’re from those ads. The girls have kept the information in their phones, and wait until they’re ready and they know they are in trouble,” Pat Upchurch, Director of Mobile Services, told Vitae.
